

Off The Ground Camper

Information Sheet

Looking for a step up from tent camping? Or a step down from a big camper? This might be what you are looking for! This is the perfect size to get 'Off The Ground' without breaking the bank on a camper that has a bunch of stuff you may not even use. What I build is for campers who just want a great place to sleep at night and store all their stuff, then go enjoy nature during the day!

- 5x10 V-nose (5' Interior)
- 2 tinted windows that open (with screens)
- 2 remote controlled ceiling fans with rain sensing auto-close
- 110V pass-through
- Holder for (2) 20lb propane tanks
- (2) 12V Accessory outlets
- 230Ah LiFePO4 Smart Battery
- Circuit breaker and fuse panel
- Remote controller multi-color LED lights inside the cabin
- Support for full-size mattress that comes out easily with a few screws. When the bed is in there is still lots of room in the front, essentially from the latch side of the man-door to the front of the trailer V.
- Standard Household exterior man-door knob and dead-bolt.
- Ceiling insulated with 1" XPS board.
- 2 small folding shelves
- Spare tire mounted to outside, lockable.
- Mudflaps
- Perimeter lighting while towing

- Tons of storage under the bed, which could also double as more sleeping space for other people, kids, or pets.
- Lightweight, easy to tow.
- Fits in a standard garage.
- Inside is 3/8" plywood, very flexible for mounting anything you might want to mount. Like Buddy Heater etc.
- D-loop next to door for locking OUT the door bar so someone doesn't lock you in it.
- Base trailer has a .080" Polycore shell, it does not wrinkle in extreme temperatures, and made in USA.

I build these conversions as I have time. I have one available now, and will be working on another one soon. Price will likely fluctuate with tariff movement on some of the components I use.

YES, there are tons of things I could do to these to make them even cooler, though I leave the personal touches to you. I'm trying to keep the pricing down as low as I can and anything else I add raises the price. I was looking at a nice teardrop in a campground recently and looked it up... it was \$25,000!! To each their own, though toss in your cook stove and tote of supplies and your set with OTG!

LiFePO4 batteries are amazing. They are expensive but last up to 10 years, have more than double the Ah that lead acid batteries, weighs 1/2 as much as lead acid batteries, and will handle over 4000 charge cycles. I took one of these on a 3 night trip and ran my fans all night, some during the days, and ran my CPAP each night, and charged my phone several times and the battery was still at 97%. The smart app lets you monitor the status of the battery from your phone including current charge status, current load, estimate hours remaining etc.
